PART 2 - GCLOBA RECORD OF STEWARDSHIP AND PRIORITIES FOR THE FUTURE

In this second installment, we report on the challenge of flooding which needs to be addressed to achieve sustainable restoration and rehabilitation of our entire Legacy site.



Following engagement with government, on 9th March, 2020, government responded by dispatching two Engineers from the Lagos State Ministry of Environment to visit School to assess environmental needs and fashion out a rehabilitation plan for the entire grounds which comprise of Government College Lagos, Eric Moore High School, Itolo Girls Secondary School, and Estate Grammar School.



The Engineers identified the problem to be an **internal drainage network problem**. They explained that there are no internal pathways/channels to carry water from the School grounds into the public drains that surround

our School. Prior to Lockdown, a report was promised which is to lead to recommendation for execution of works to rectify the problem.
